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Little Girls, Big Challenge!

This Sunday 8-year-old twins Natasha and Natalia are riding 10km in the Spring Financial Group Spring Cycle and fundraising to give children living with disability the chance to ride a bike.

At 20 weeks of pregnancy, parents Ljubica (Lou) and Josh learnt that their twin girls had Twin to Twin Transfusion Syndrome. Immediate surgery was conducted but as a side effect, Natasha had a stroke. Mum, Lou tells the story:

"At 30 weeks I was given the option of terminating my pregnancy. I said No! We saw a neurologist and he painted the picture of what Natasha's disability would look like.

Today Natasha is a happy, sensitive and loving 8-year-old girl. She lives with Cerebral Palsy which affects the right side of her body, but she keeps up with her twin sister Natalia.

We live near the Botanical Gardens in Picton which has a lovely, big bike track where many kids and families ride together.

Josh would take our eldest daughter Lily and Natalia for rides through the park. Because of her disability Natasha couldn't steer or grip the handlebars of a standard bike and she always missed out on this activity.

Back in May Natasha's therapist referred us to Freedom Wheels. We came to an assessment and Natasha was fitted for a special bike that met her needs.

Natasha was so happy that day, it was the first time she could ride independently!

After the assessment, Natasha kept asking us, "When am I going to get a bike, when am I going to get it?" I just had to keep saying soon but we couldn't access funding through NDIS.



Last Month we received a surprise call from Freedom Wheels. I couldn't believe what I was hearing, Natasha's bike had been funded by donations from Spring Cycle riders!

A week later Natasha had her bike! It was so good to see her riding with her sisters, I was in tears.

Now her life will change! Natasha will be able to join in! This will help her to bond with her sisters and feel included, especially with dad. Natasha is very much a daddy's girl.

This Sunday Natasha and Natalia are riding the Harbour Bridge with dad Josh and sister Lily to help raise funds so that more kids living with disability will have the chance to ride a bike," said Ljubica.
